Senator Waters asked:

1. Previously, GBRMPA has expressed a desire to put in quantitative limits on offshore dumping of maintenance dredging. Since there are about 1 million m³ of maintenance dredge spoil dumped in the Reef every year, what level are you proposing?

2. Are you still hopeful of getting hard limits included?

Answer:

- 1. The Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority understands that quantitative limits have been examined as part of the development of the maintenance dredging framework.
