**Topic: Transcription service Senator Brown, Carol asked:** 

- 1. The ABC has made a decision to cease transcribing some of its news and current affairs programs. A cut that will save the ABC just \$210,000. The ABC has indicated it is developing a "broader access strategy" and that in the interim changes to the ABC news transcription arrangements will be wound back as far as practicable while the strategy is being drafted.
  - (a) Has the ABC completed this strategy? If not when will it be completed?
  - (b) When will the transcription services be reinstated in full?
