## Senator Ludwig asked:

Since 7 September 2013:

- 1. How many requests for documents under the FOI Act have been received?
- 2. Of these, how many documents have been determined to be deliberative documents?
- 3. Of those assessed as deliberative documents:
  - a. For how many has access to the document been refused on the basis that it would be contrary to the public interest?
  - b. For how many has a redacted document been provided?

#### **Answer:**

The following answers relate to the period 7 September 2013 to 28 May 2014:

- 1. 31.
- 2. Of the 31 requests, 5 requests included a finding that one or more documents contained deliberative matter and were exempt under s47C of the *Freedom of Information Act* 1982. A total of 43 documents were determined to be exempt under s47C.
