Topic: Independent Audit of the NBN Policy Process

Senator Urquhart asked:

Senator URQUHART: So the minister appointed Bill Scales to undertake the independent audit of the NBN policy process. What is the payment that Mr Scales is receiving for that? **Mr Clarke:** I will clarify my previous answer. I have been advised that we do use Pitney Rowes.

Mr Clarke: I will clarify my previous answer. I have been advised that we do use Pitney Bowes services and data for applications in addition to My Broadband, but I think it is probably the current largest one. But it is not exclusively applied to that website. Your question was with regard to Mr Scales?

Senator URQUHART: Yes. For the independent audit of the NBN policy process. What is he being paid for that?

Mr Robinson: He is being paid \$1,500 per day.

Senator URQUHART: Per day?

Mr Robinson: Yes.

Senator CONROY: How many days has he worked so far?

Mr Robinson: I would have to take that on notice.

Senator URQUHART: Did we get an answer? I was going to ask that very next question.

Senator CONROY: He has taken it on notice.

Senator CONROY: Could we get a table including other expenses? **Senator URQUHART**: Yes. That is what I would like as well, thanks.

Mr Robinson: Yes.

Answer:

For the period 1 February to 6 August 2014, the following costs were paid in regard to the Independent Auditor and Secretariat (please note, whilst the daily rate of \$1,500 is inclusive of GST, the following costs are all GST exclusive):

Mr Scales worked 41.75 days at a total cost of \$56,932 (\$1,363.64 per day) and incurred \$12,794 of travel related expenses.

The Secretariat comprised four staff, 1x SES Band 3 (equivalent) and 3 APS level staff at an EL2, EL1 and APS 4 level. Remuneration for the Secretariat was \$225,323 and expenses incurred were \$13,747.

An additional cost of the Audit was a fee for service contract at a cost of \$32,545 for research.
