Senator Ludwig asked:

Answer:

- 1. As at 30 April 2014, there were 210 active cardholders in the Department. An official is eligible for a corporate credit card where the official:
 - is an SES officer; or
 - purchases property or services on behalf of the Department; or
 - travels on official business on behalf of the Department; or
 - is an officer who books travel on behalf of travellers.
