# **Topic: Staffing recruitment**

### Senator Ludwig asked:

- 1. How many ongoing staff were recruited from 25 February 2014 to date? What classification are these staff?
- 2. How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created from 25 February 2014 to date? What classification are these staff?
- 3. From 25 February 2014 to date, how many employees have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

#### **Answer:**

- 1. No ongoing staff were recruited between 25 February 2014 and 30 April 2014.
- 2. Including casual positions, a total of 27 non-ongoing positions existed at 25 February 2014 reducing to 22 at 30 April 2014, as shown in the table below:

3. From 25 February 2014 to 30 April 2014, eight employees have been employed on non-ongoing contracts and the average length of their employment period of 0.34 months.
