Considering that CCG, the developer's architects, in their executive summary for the aged care facility propose an archival record and a professionally assembled interpretive programme, how is this consistent with adaptive re-use? Is that not an acknowledgment that substantial demolition of a Commonwealth Heritage listed place would in fact occur?

Answer:

No.

Archival recording and an interpretive program is usually required for adaptive re-use.
