Answer:

The Office of Water Science as the secretariat to the Independent Expert Scientific Committee (IESC), provided to the IESC a copy of the "Review of the Carmichael Coal Mine and Rail Project Water Hydrogeology Report" completed by Dr Noel Merrick of Hydro Simulations.
