Answer:

- 1. Disputes between the ABC and its staff are generally mediated and resolved internally using the expertise of staff within ABC People (HR) or Legal Services. Occasionally, an external mediator is engaged to assist with more complex mediations and sometimes matters which have an industrial aspect are referred to the Fair Work Commission.
