**Senator Ludlam asked:**

Can you provide us, maybe on notice, with an accurate set of maps of exactly what the footprint of the two HFC networks is, because it is actually remarkably difficult to find.

**Mr Adcock:** We can take it on notice. We have been provided some information as part of the negotiations.

**Answer:**

As part of the agreements between NBN Co and Telstra and Optus respectively in relation to their HFC networks, NBN Co has been provided with confidential data relating to the geographic location of their respective HFC networks. This map data remains 'commercial-in-confidence' and is not currently available for release.
