 - 6. Why the building was necessary for the operations of the agency / department.

Answer:

- 1. Building lease charges (base rent only) from July to end of November 2014 are
 - 1. Amount paid \$85,595.66 (GST exclusive)
 - 2. Actual charges \$23,276 per month \$116,380 (GST exclusive).

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The difference between paid and charged is due to the rent free period which ended mid-August 2014.

- 2. Please provide a detailed list of each building that is currently leased. Please detail by:
 - 1. The Telecommunications Universal Service Management Agency (TUSMA) currently leases within Melbourne Central Tower on 360 Elizabeth Street. The lease was signed on 4 April 2013.
 - 2. The termination of the lease is 3 April 2019.
 - 3. Consideration about any renewal of the lease is anticipated closer to its 2019 expiry date.
 - 4. Location of the premises is in Melbourne CBD, Victoria.
 - 5. Base rent is \$279,312 per annum (GST exclusive) for the period May 2014 to April 2015 with 1 4 percent indexation to apply from April 2015.
 - 6. The location of the agency is within close proximity to our key suppliers, stakeholders and other government agencies.
