**Senator Ludwig asked:**

Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014:

1. How many documents (include the amount of copies) have been printed?
  1. How many of these printed documents were also published online?
2. Has the Department/Agency used external printing services for any print jobs?
  1. If so, what companies were used?
  2. How were they selected?
  3. What was the total cost of this printing by item?

**Answer:**

- 1&2. Australia Post has had numerous documents printed since 1 June 2014 to 31 October 2014, some of which are published on its website [www.auspost.com.au](http://www.auspost.com.au). The specific details sought about documents printed across the entire corporation are not captured on any central database.
