Senator Urquhart, Anne asked:

Please clarify what “no travel allowance has been paid to the CEO” means. Is this simply for travel between the Canberra and Sydney, or does it also include the Melbourne office and other national and international business travel?

Answer: The response “no travel allowance has been paid to the CEO” means that no travel allowance, as defined in the NFSA’s Enterprise Agreement, was paid to the CEO for any travel.

Were airfares and accommodation paid for?

Answer: Some airfares, accommodation and other transport costs were paid for by the NFSA. Accommodation costs were not paid for travel in Canberra or Sydney by the NFSA.

What was the cost?

Answer: To attempt to provide the detail requested would involve an unreasonable diversion of resources as this information is recorded as part of a broader category of expenses.
