 Can you provide a list of the 26 species that have been removed from the Commonwealth's list of threatened species between 18 September 2013 and now, and why those species have been removed?

Answer:

Between 18 September 2013 and 26 October 2015, 41 species were removed from the list of threatened species established under the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Act* 1999. Aphanes pentamera	plant	A herb that has been reassessed and found to be ineligible

Carex paupera	plant	A sedge that is now considered the same as <i>C. inversa</i> , which is not threatened
Centrolepis caespitosa	plant	A herb that has been reassessed and found to be ineligible
Corybas sp. Finniss (R.Bates 28794)	plant	A helmet-orchid that is now considered the same as <i>C. dentatus</i> , a threatened species that remains listed as vulnerable

Grevillea scortechinii subsp. sarmentosa	plant	A grevillea that has been reassessed and found to be ineligible
Hydrocharis dubia	plant	An aquatic plant that has been reassessed and found to be ineligible
Phaius tancarvilleae	plant	A tropical orchid that is now considered the same as <i>P. australis</i> , a threatened species that remains listed as endangered
Prasophyllum uroglossum	plant	A leek-orchid that is now considered the same as <i>P. fuscum</i> , a threatened that remains listed as vulnerable
Pterostylis atriola	plant	An orchid that has been reassessed and found to be ineligible
Pterostylis cobarensis	plant	An orchid that has been reassessed and found to be ineligible
Ptychosperma bleeseri	plant	A palm that is now considered the same as <i>Ptychosperma</i> macarthurii, which is not threatened
Rytidosperma popinensis	plant	A grass species that is now considered the same as <i>R. fulvum</i> , which is not threatened
Sarcochilus roseus	plant	A subtropical orchid that is now considered the same as <i>S. ceciliae</i> , which is not threatened
Sauropus filicinus	plant	A shrub that has been reassessed and found to be ineligible
Senecio garlandii	plant	A perennial herb that has been reassessed and found to be ineligible
Senecio laticostatus	plant	A perennial herb that is now considered to be a hybrid of Senecio glomeratus subsp. longifructus, which is not threatened
Solanum carduiforme	plant	A shrub that has been reassessed and found to be ineligible
Taeniophyllum muelleri	plant	An orchid that was incorrectly described and due to a taxonomic change is now considered to be widespread and common has been reassessed and found to be ineligible
Tasmannia purpurascens	plant	A shrub that has been reassessed and found to be ineligible
Tetratheca glandulosa	plant	A shrub that has been reassessed and found to be ineligible
Tinospora tinosporoides	plant	A vine that has been reassessed and found to be ineligible
Verticordia plumosa var.	plant	A featherflower that is now considered the same as <i>V. p.</i> var.
