Senator BUSHBY asked:

- 1878. How many Ministers have you had in the past three years before the election and in particular in the year preceding the election?
- 1879. What costs or disruption have you faced from pre-election changes of Ministers, whether IT costs, preparation of new briefings, changes of style guides and information products to suit new Ministers?

Answer:
