Senator BUSHBY asked:

1917. How much has your agency spent in the last year on PR firms, focus groups, lobbyists or external communications contracts or services? What were the decision processes for those contracts and what was the level of Ministerial or Minister office input into those decisions?

Answer:

1917. The Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA) spent \$9680 on external communications services in the 12 months to 28 February 2014. The contract was entered into following a limited tender based upon APRA's business needs.

There was no Ministerial or Ministerial office input into the decision process.
