Senator BUSHBY asked:

3110. Can the agency advise how many positions it has sought to have treated as requiring recruitment from the open market under current arrangements for centralised government vetting of recruitment proposals?
3111. How many exemptions has the agency been given to permit recruitment, bulk recruitment and boutique?

Answer:

3110. – 3111. As the Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA) is a non-Australian Public Service agency it is covered by and adheres to the Interim Recruitment Arrangements – Non APS Commonwealth Agencies. APRA fills vacancies in accordance with these Arrangements.
