Senator BUSHBY asked:

- 3110. Can the agency advise how many positions it has sought to have treated as requiring recruitment from the open market under current arrangements for centralised government vetting of recruitment proposals?
- 3111. How many exemptions has the agency been given to permit recruitment, bulk recruitment and boutique?

Answer:

3110. – 3111. As the Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA) is a non-Australian Public Service agency it is covered by and adheres to the Interim Recruitment Arrangements – Non APS Commonwealth Agencies. APRA fills vacancies in accordance with these Arrangements.
