Senator LUDWIG asked:

381. Is electronic equipment (such as ipad, laptop, wireless card, vasco token, blackberry, mobile phone (list type if relevant), thumb drive) provided to department/agency staff? If yes provide a list of what is provided across the department of agency, the purchase cost, the ongoing cost and a breakdown of what staff and staff classification receives each item.

Answer:

381. Yes. The breakdown of staff who receive electronic equipment and the purchase and ongoing costs for reporting for the period 1 December 2013 to 28 February 2014 is as follows:
