Senator KIM CARR: What is the difference in the two bodies, the one that was formerly appointed by the minister and announced for abolition in MYEFO and the one that you are now running through the board?

ANSWER

Direct expenditure for the Australia Telescope Steering Committee (ATSC) in the 2013-14 financial year and including the face-to-face meeting in July 2014, was approximately \$15,000 (excl gst).

CSIRO expects the cost of the newly constituted ATSC to be similar.
