ANSWER

- a) As at 3 March 2016, around 700 representatives of industry, government and research organisations have attended consultation sessions.

- c) The consultations are led by the Interim Chair of the CRC, Mr John Wharton AM, with support from the Department of Industry, Innovation and Science and Bendelta Pty Ltd (a strategic advisory firm engaged to assist the Interim Chair).
- d) The Department of Industry, Innovation and Science is contributing officials. Members of the Single Business Service Programme and CRC Programme Branch and National Outreach Network in AusIndustry Business Services Division are providing logistic support and information on the CRC Programme and other Government initiatives, and assisting the Interim Chair. They have been supported by the Office of Northern Australia and policy colleagues from the Science and Commercialisation Policy Division.

- f) State and territory agencies have been engaged in direct consultation with the Interim Chair and the Department of Industry, Innovation and Science. Consultations with potential partner organisations are continuing.
