There was an announcement by the government yesterday that the government intends to press ahead with parallel imports of used cars—I say a car with 500 kilometres on the clock is a used car. I know you will tell me that this is someone else's portfolio.

Mr Chesworth: It was a decision of the cabinet, so the department was involved in the normal processes that lead to consideration by cabinet.
