QUESTION No.: AI-38

- 1. What is the current status of the Briquette Replacement Program?
- 2. What applications had the department received from Gippsland Greenhouse Produce and AJ&AN Bayley of Yarragon under that program?
- 3. What was the last communication that the department had with either firm, and what was the nature of the communication?
- 4. When were the firms advised that the Briquette Replacement Program would be ending?
- 5. What advice did the department provide the firms about what options were available to them given they had already begun making investments in their businesses?

ANSWER

- 1. The Briquette Replacement Program is closed.
- 2. Gippsland Greenhouse Produce submitted an application for \$696,391 on 12 July 2013. AJ&AN Bayley submitted an application for \$571,401 on 12 July 2013.
- 3. On 19 December 2013, the department's AusIndustry Regional Manager for Gippsland visited both companies to provide advice on current assistance measures.
- 4. On 16 December 2013, the department wrote to and phoned both companies advising that the Government had decided to discontinue the Briquette Replacement Program and that no applications would be funded.
- 5. The department's correspondence of 16 December 2013 to both companies provided advice in relation to a range of key policy initiatives and programmes that support agriculture and food processing businesses.
