Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

ANSWER

- 1. The department does not own any cars (passenger vehicles).
- 2-5. Not applicable
- 6. The Department leases 56 cars (passenger vehicles) as at 31 January 2016.
- 7. The Department's leased cars are located in each State and Territory in Australia.
- 8. The Department's fleet consists of 24 pool cars which are used for the collection and delivery of goods and for travel to remote locations. In addition, there are 18 AusIndustry Regional Manager cars and 14 Executive Scheme Vehicles (SES officers).
- 9-10. The total cost of the 56 leased cars from 1 September 2015 to 31 January 2016 was \$287,275. The total kilometres travelled by the leased cars was approximately 452,590 kilometers. To provide this data on an individual passenger car basis would be an unreasonable diversion of departmental resources.
