Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

1. How many requests for documents under the FOI Act have been received?

- 2. Of these, how many documents have been determined to be deliberative documents?
- 3. Of those assessed as deliberative documents:
  - 1) For how many has access to the document been refused on the basis that it would be contrary to the public interest?
  - 2) For how many has a redacted document been provided?

## **ANSWER**

- 1. The Department of Industry, Innovation and Science (the department) received 37 requests for documents under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (the FOI Act) in the period 14 September 2015 to 23 February 2016. Of the 37 requests received, the department finalised 31 requests as at 23 February 2016.
- 2. Of the 31 finalised requests no documents were determined to be deliberative documents.
