Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1515. How much has been spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers / Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio to date?
- a) Detail the items provided to the minister's office.
- b) Please specify how many reams of paper have been supplied to the Minister's office.
- 1516. How much has been spent on departmental stationary requirements to date.
- 1517. Has any customised stationery been requested or provided to the Minister or Ministerial Staff? If yes, please include a photo/scan, detail the type of stationery, date it was requested, date it was provided and the cost.

Answer:

- 1515. The Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA) does not pay for Minister's or Parliamentary Secretary's stationery requirements.
