1967. Not applicable,

1968. The agency has access to 40 desktop computers and 13 laptops under an arrangement with the Department of the Treasury, who own these assets. All computers and laptops are located in Canberra.

1969. The agency uses Microsoft Windows 7 Service Pack 1 as the operating system on all computers and laptops. The operating system is contracted under the Microsoft Volume Sourcing Agreement II (Microsoft VSAII). Ongoing costs are \$8,077.13 per annum.
