Question:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 3338. How much has been spent on workplace ergonomic assessments?
 - a) List each item of expenditure and cost
- 3339. Have any assessments, not related to an existing disability, resulted in changes to workplace equipment or set up?
- 3340. If so, list each item of expenditure and cost related to those changes

Answer:

- 3338. From 14 September 2015 to 19 February 2016, the Treasury spent \$14,523 (GST inclusive) on workstation assessments.
 - a) During this period, 55 workstation assessments were undertaken by external providers. Their cost varies based on complexity and duration.
- 3339. Yes.
- 3340. From 14 September 2015 to 19 February 2016, the Treasury spent \$23,676 (GST inclusive) on ergonomic equipment arising from workstation assessments, such as chairs, sit/stand desks, keyboards, mice, document holders and footrests.
