Question:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 651. How many ongoing staff have been recruited? What classification are these staff?
- 652. How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created? What classification are these staff?
- 653. How many staff have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

Answer:

651. The ACNC recruited 17 ongoing staff members in the period of 14 September 2015 – 3 March 2016 and the classification breakdown is as follows:

The 17 ongoing appointments consisted of 12 promotions (internal promotion or promotion from the ATO) as well as five new appointments. All the engagements were to fill vacancies that occurred during the Australian Public Service recruitment freeze.

652. The ACNC currently has three non-ongoing positions. The classification of the staff members is as follows:

653. The ACNC employed seven contractors during the period 14 September 2015 - 3 March 2016. The average length of employment for contractors is between 6 - 12 months. Contractors are engaged to assist core functions of the business during the peak periods.
