- 8. Does a regular meeting occur between the ACCC and, separately, the AER and the ministerial advisers? How frequently do these meetings occur? Please provide copies of the agendas, talking points, and any action minutes taken at each of the last 12 of these meetings."

Answer:

- 1-5. The ACCC and AER provide briefs to relevant ministers on a range of matters, either providing information on relevant issues, detailing a report to be tabled in Parliament or to make a recommendation. The ACCC is not in a position to disclose the nature of its advice to Government.

- 7-8. The ACCC and AER meet with relevant Ministers and ministerial advisers as required or on a needs basis to ensure they are kept informed of activities in line with the Government's Statement of Expectations and the Statement of Intent, available online:
