## **Question:**

1. Does the ABS have an iTunes account?

- 2. If so, what was the total expenditure on iTunes in calendar year 2016 (GST inclusive)?
- 3. What applications/subscriptions/services purchased through iTunes in calendar year 2016?
- 4. Does the ABS have an Android account?
- 5. If so, what was the total expenditure on Android in calendar year 2016 (GST inclusive)?
- 6. What applications/subscriptions/services purchased through Android in calendar year 2016?

### **Answer:**

- 1. The ABS has an Apple Developer Account to publish the ABS Stats app. ABS staff issued with a corporate iPhone or iPad have delegation to make purchases of essential productivity applications using a corporate credit card. Any such purchases are reviewed by line management.
- 2. The annual cost of the Apple Developer Account is \$149AUD. The total expenditure on iTunes in 2016 was a single purchase of \$22.99.
- 3. The single iTunes purchase in 2016 was for iPad Teleprompter software used during video recording of ABS corporate presentations.
- 4. Does the ABS have an Android account? No. The ABS has, however, a Google Play publisher account to publish the ABS Stats app.
- 5. The annual cost of the Google Play publisher account is \$25USD.
