In all other ACCC offices the electricity purchase varies dependant on what was negotiated at the commencement of the lease agreement. As these other sites are small (under 500m2) the power is purchased via outgoings as part of recharge from the Lessor.

- 1292. Electricity costs for all ACCC offices in 2009-10 were \$320 020, and in 2010-11 were \$348 277.
- 1293. Electricity costs for all ACCC offices for the 2011-12 financial year to date (1 July 2011 to 31 May 2012) were approximately \$281 681 (GST exclusive).
