Senator BUSHBY asked:

- 737. What was the total cost of media monitoring services, including press clippings, electronic media transcripts etcetera, provided to the Minister's office for this financial year to date?
 - a) Which agency or agencies provided these services?
 - b) What is the estimated budget to provide these same services for the year 2012-13?
 - c) What has been spent providing these services this financial year to date?
- 738. What was the total cost of media monitoring services, including press clippings, electronic media transcripts etcetera, provided to the department/agency for this financial year to date?
 - a) Which agency or agencies provided these services?
 - b) What is the estimated budget to provide these same services for the year 2012-13?
 - c) What has been spent providing these services this financial year to date?

Answer:

- 737. The ATO did not provide media monitoring services to any Minister during the financial year to 31 May 2012 and there is no planned expenditure for 2012-13.
- 738. For the period 1 July 2011 to 31 May 2012, the ATO spent \$296,894 on media monitoring services.
 - (a) The ATO currently has two providers of monitoring services: Media Monitors and Australian Associated Press. The Media Monitors contract expires in October 2012 and after this Media Monitors will no longer provide a media monitoring service to the ATO.
 - (b) As the same level of media monitoring services will be provided by a single supplier post October 2012, the estimated budget for 2012-13 is \$220,000.
 - (c) During 2011-12 (to 31 May 2012), the ATO spent \$296,894 on media monitoring services to 31 May 2012.
