Senator BUSHBY asked:

- 859. How much did each department/agency spend on taxis this financial year to date? Provide a breakdown of each business group in each department/agency.
- 860. What are the reasons for taxi costs?

Answer:

859. The ATO (including the Australian Valuation Office, Tax Practitioners Board and the Australian Business Register) spent \$4.4 million (excluding GST) on taxis and hire cars from 1 July 2011 to 31 May 2012.
