## Senator BUSHBY asked:

- 935. How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio (i.e. paper, envelopes, with compliments slips) this financial year to date?
- 936. What is the department/agency's stationery costs for the financial year to date?
- 937. What was the department/agency's stationery costs for 2009-10 and 2010-11?

# Answer:

- 935. APRA does not pay for Ministers' or Parliamentary Secretaries' stationery requirements.
- 936. APRA has spent \$69,681.97 on stationery for the financial year to 31 May 2012.
- 937. APRA spent \$141,098.50 and \$122,283.49 on stationery for the financial years ending 30 June 2010 and 30 June 2011 respectively.
