**Senator BUSHBY asked:**

950. How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio (i.e. paper, envelopes, with compliments slips) this financial year to date?
951. What is the department/agency's stationery costs for the financial year to date?
952. What was the department/agency's stationery costs for 2009-10 and 2010-11?

**Answer:**

950. Nil.
951. In the period from 1 July 2011 to 31 May 2012, the AOFM spent approximately \$8,440 on stationery.
952. In the 2010-2011 financial year, the AOFM spent approximately \$ 8,937 on stationery. In the 2009-2010 financial year, the AOFM spent approximately \$10,375 on stationery.
