Senator BUSHBY asked:

- 1074. How much did each department/agency spend on taxis this financial year to date*? Provide a breakdown for each business group in each department/agency.
 - a. What are the reasons for taxi costs?

Answer:

1074. In 2012-13 to 31 May 2013, the ATO (including the Australian Charities and Not for Profits Commission, Australian Valuation Office, Australian Business Register and Tax Practitioners Board) spent \$3,769,781 (excluding GST) on taxis.

The ATO is a large national organisation that is located around Australia with over 80 per cent of staff located outside of Canberra. There is a need for the ATO to connect with the community, businesses, tax professionals and staff, requiring travel for a number of employees in the course of their ordinary duties. Taxi costs are typically incurred in the process of undertaking this official travel.
