**Senator BUSHBY asked:**

434. How many cars are owned by each department/agency?
- a) Where are the cars located?
  - b) What are the cars used for?
  - c) What is the cost of each car for this financial year to date\*?
  - d) How far has each car travelled this financial year to date\*?

\*Financial year – 31 May 2013

**Answer:**

434. The Treasury owns two cars.
- a) The cars are located in New Delhi, India and Beijing, China
  - b) The cars are used for official business and personal use.
  - c) The running costs for the car in Beijing for this financial year to 31 May 2013 was \$5,603.43. The running costs for the car in New Delhi for this financial year to 31 May 2013 was \$1,306.11.
  - d) The distance the Beijing car travelled for this period is 15,353 km and the total distance the New Delhi car travelled is 9,078 km.
