## Senator BUSHBY asked:

481. What is the department/agency's hospitality spend for this financial year to date? Detail the date, location, purpose and cost of all events, including any catering and drinks costs.
482. What hospitality spend is the department/agency planning on spending? Detail the date, location, purpose and cost of all events, including any catering and drinks costs.
483. What is the department/agency's entertainment spend for this financial year to date? Detail the date, location, purpose and cost of all events, including any catering and drinks costs.
484. What entertainment spend is the department/agency planning on spending? Detail the date, location, purpose and cost of all events, including any catering and drinks costs.
485. Is the department/agency planning on reducing any of its spending on these items? If so, how will reductions be achieved and what are the estimated savings over each year of the forward estimates?

## Answer:

481. The YTD hospitality spend to 31 May 2013 is $\$ 140,260$ (excluding GST). The date, location, purpose and cost of these events are as follows:

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482. Hospitality expenditure for $2012 / 13$ is budgeted at $\$ 179,117$. Apart from the actual expenditure and details reported to 31 May 2013, no specific details around planned hospitality are readily available.
483. There has been no entertainment spent for the financial year to 31 May 2013.
484. There is no planned entertainment spend for the 2012-13 financial year.
485. As noted at Question BET 468, business unit budgets are reduced in order to realise required ASIC wide savings, leaving senior executive leaders the scope to align expenditure with their priorities through business plans.
