- 1682. How much has been spent on workplace ergonomic assessments since 7 September 2013\*?

## **Answer:**

- 1682. The Australian Prudential Regulation Authority spent \$260.00 on one formal workplace ergonomic assessment during the period 7 September 2013 to 12 June 2014.
