## Question

- 1739. What is the Department/Agency's hospitality spend from Additional Estimates in February, 2014\* to date including any catering and drinks costs.
- 1740. What hospitality spend is the Department/Agency's planning on spending? Detail date, location, purpose and cost of all events including any catering and drinks costs.
- 1741. What entertainment spend is the Department/Agency's planning on spending? Detail date, location, purpose and cost of all events including any catering and drinks costs.
- 1742. Is the Department/Agency planning on reducing any of its spending on these items? If so, how will reductions be achieved?

## **Answer:**
