- 392. Disputes between departmental and/or agency staff may be managed internally by staff convening informal meetings and discussions to resolve the matter or they may be mediated with the assistance of outside firms.
 - Yes. In the financial year 2014-15 Optum were engaged to assist with one mediation.
 - a) It was a one-off payment for pre mediation, report writing and correspondence.
 - b) \$1,815 (inc. GST) has been paid to Optum since the last budget.
 - c) The contract with the firm commenced on 26 September 2014.
 - d) The contract with the firm expired on 13 January 2015.
 - e) Optum is the ACCC's Employee Assistance Program provider and was selected to provide the service.
 - f) The one matter referred to Optum involved manager and staff concerning a conduct and performance matter.

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- 394. Code of conduct violations by departmental and/or agency staff are managed by ACCC staff or outside firms are engaged to mediate the matter.
- 395. No outside firms have been contracted to assist with mediation since the last budget.
