# **Question:**

- 460. What is the Department/Agency's policy with regard to hiring non-Australian citizens?
- 461. Does the agency have a Culturally and Linguistically Diverse (CALD) policy? If yes, please provide a summary.
- 462. How does the Department/Agency determine whether a person is a non-Australian citizen?
- 463. How many staff who were not Australian Citizens have been hired by the Department/Agency since the Federal Election in September, 2013? Please break the numbers down by:
  - a) Levels at which they are employed
  - b) Immigration Status (Visa)
  - c) Cultural Background
  - d) Linguistic Background
  - e) How many were hired to satisfy CALD targets?

### Answer:

- 460. It is a requirement that employees be Australian citizens, unless the Chairman waives the requirement based on particular needs of the Commission.

- 462. Applicants are required to declare their citizenship on applying for a position. Citizenship is a condition of engagement. Birth certificate, passport or certificate of citizenship are provided by successful applicants.
