Senator KIM CARR: What are the net job losses now in terms of Oceans and Atmosphere?

Dr Mayfield: I do not have the numbers in terms of net losses ahead of me. I can provide that on notice, but, in terms of the Climate Science Centre, I can pass to the director who I have here with me, Helen Cleugh. We are currently expecting the centre to grow to 131 FTEs.

Senator KIM CARR: What was it last year?

Dr Mayfield: Last year, we were around 114, with an expectation to grow to 124. We now expect to

grow to 131.

Senator KIM CARR: What was it the year before?

Dr Mayfield: I do not have those numbers in front of me.

Senator KIM CARR: That is where we get the job losses—the previous year.

Dr Mayfield: I would have to take that one on notice.

The staff numbers (FTE) for CSIRO Oceans & Atmosphere (O&A) since 30 June 2015 are provided in the table below.
