Question:

Noting the enormous and growing size of government, is it the case that independent agencies such as the Productivity Commission (PC), Australian National Audit Office (ANAO) and Parliamentary Budget Office (PBO) should be given more responsibilities and resources for such functions as budget transparency portals (like that advocated by the Australian Taxpayers' Association), dynamic tax modelling (based on Laffer Curve principles like the American Enterprise Institute's TaxBrain) and cost-benefit-analysis (CBA) of major policies, legislation and regulations?

Answer:

It is a matter for the Parliament to determine the responsibilities of statutory agencies such as the Productivity Commission, Australian National Audit Office, and Parliamentary Budget Office.
