Consultations on eligibility criteria

#### **Question:**

1. The fact sheet states that the eligibility criteria for assistance and other requirements will be informed through consultations.

- a) Will the consultations be conducted by Treasury?
- b) Is there a timeframe? When will consultations commence? When will they conclude?
- c) Who will be consulted?
- 2. The board of the National Housing Finance and Investment Corporation will be assessing applications for finance from 1 July 2018, which is also the date on which NHFIC will commence operations. Will program guidelines be ready by 1 July 2018 so that the NHFIC board can assess applications against them?
- 3. Who will develop the Fund guidelines?
- 4. Will the Fund be subject to ANAO oversight?

#### **Answer:**

- 1a) Treasury will lead consultations seeking stakeholder views in 2017-18 on issues such as the eligibility criteria for financial assistance.
- b) Consultations have commenced and will run through 2017-18. A public discussion paper is also expected to be released in the second half of 2017.
- c) Consultation will be with a range of stakeholders including state governments, local governments and the private sector.
- 2. It is expected that an independent Board will assess applications for financial assistance from local governments for the NHIF from 1 July 2018.
- 3. Guidelines for the NHIF will be developed by Treasury and agreed by the Government in consultation with stakeholders.
- 4. If an entity is considered a Commonwealth entity under the PGPA Act, section 43 requires the Audit of annual financial statements for Commonwealth entities by the Auditor-General. Section 11 of the Auditor-General Act outlines the Auditor-General's functions, including auditing the annual financial statements of Commonwealth entities in accordance with the PGPA Act.
