# **Question:**

Since 7 September 2013:

  - a) What is the process by which these therapies can be approved?
  - b) Who are they available to?
  - c) Please detail the reasons the therapies able to be provided (e.g. Work Place Agreement, recommended by a report to the department, etc)?
