Question:

Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014:

400. How many cars are owned by each department/agency?
- a) Where are the cars located?
 - b) What are the cars used for?
 - c) What is the cost of each car during the specified period?
 - d) How far did each car travel during the specified period?
401. How many cars are leased by each department/agency?
- a) Where are the cars located?
 - b) What are the cars used for?
 - c) What is the cost of each car during the specified period?

Answer:

400. The Treasury owns two cars.
- a) The cars are located in New Delhi, India and Beijing, China.
 - b) The cars are used for official business and personal use.
 - c) The running costs for the car in Beijing from 1 June 2014 to 31 October 2014 was \$2,605.18.
The running costs for the car in New Delhi from 1 June 2014 to 30 October 2014 was \$1,204.53
 - d) The distance the Beijing car travelled for this period is 7,551 km and the total distance the New Delhi car travelled is 5,289 km.
401. The Treasury leases four cars.
- a) The cars are located in Canberra, ACT.
 - b) The cars are used for official business.
 - c) The cost of each car is as follows:
Corporate Car – FFMD – \$4,855.62
Corporate Car – MCD – \$4,530.20
Corporate Car – IT – \$6,074.63
Minister - \$4,892.77
