- 854. What date did/will cloud services be deployed in the department?
- 855. Please provide a list of all cloud services in use or being considered for use.
- 856. How much do these services cost? Please break down by service.
- 857. How much cloud storage (in gigabytes) is available for departmental use? What percentage of the available total is in use?
- 858. How much does this cloud storage cost per month?
- 859. What security arrangements are in place to protect cloud based services and storage?
- 860. Have any security analysts been employed / contracted to advise on the implementation and upkeep of these security arrangements?
- 861. What has been the cost of security for the cloud? Please provide a breakdown.

- 855. Website hosting; hosting of an online consultation tool; IT project tracking (software as a service).
- 856. Website hosting \$82,200 per year; online consultation tool hosting \$5,000 per year; IT project tracking \$36,000 per year (noting this also includes software licensing costs which are not provided separately to hosting costs).
- 857. The ACCC does not use cloud services specifically for data storage.
- 858. Not applicable.
- 859. Risk assessments are conducted prior to establishing new cloud services.
- 860. No security analysts have been engaged specifically to provide advice on cloud services. The ACCC's IT Security Advisor provides advice on cloud services as required.
