Since 1 January 2015:

1766. How many cars are owned by each department/agency?

1767. How many cars are leased by each department/agency?

- a) Where are the cars located?
- b) What are the cars used for?
- c) What is the cost of each car during the specified period?

**Answer:**

1766: Nil.

1767: Since 1 January to 31 October 2015, ASIC leased 7 corporate cars.

In addition, ASIC also has two Executive Vehicle Scheme (EVS) cars leased to 2 Senior Executive Staff (SES) as part of their individual employment package.

- a) The 7 leased corporate cars were located in the secure parking facilities of each ASIC office, as set out on the table below. The 2 EVS leased cars are both located in Sydney.
- b) The 7 leased corporate cars were used for ASIC official business purposes. The 2 EVS leased vehicles were used for business and private use.
